Categories:

1. LEADERSHIP AWARD – presented to an individual who is recognized for major contributions, which have fostered significant improvements in one or more of the eight components of comprehensive school health programs. The nominee may be a health professional, teacher, school administrator, county or state official, legislator, health advocate, or one whose leadership efforts on behalf of the goals of the Maryland State School Health Council have resulted in meaningful improvement in school health. The Leadership Award is for a career of contribution to the cause of school health OVER MANY YEARS.

2. ACHIEVEMENT AWARD – same eligibility as above but recognizes achievements during ONE YEAR ONLY. This is not a career award, and this year's award pertains to school year 2005-2006.

3. PROGRAM AWARD – presented to a group, organization, or agency that has contributed significantly to the promotion of comprehensive school health programs in Maryland with a model program, initiative, or event during school year 2005-2006.
